Barack's Obamatini

Mixing Instructions

Mix gin, vermouth and olive juice in cocktail shaker with ice. Shake, then immediately remove from ice into cocktail glass. Garnish with onions and olives alternating on a toothpick.

Action Instructions

Reassure customer that Middle East peace is possible if we have his/her support. Customer should say, "President Obama, you have my support to make peace in the Middle East! I can taste the 1 ½ oz of Hope and its Delicious!" Then get on all fours and bark like a Portuguese Water dog.

INGREDIENTS:

1.5 OZ GIN
1 SPLASH DRY VERMOUTH
2 COCKTAIL ONION
2 OLIVES,
1 DASH OLIVE JUICE
1.5 OZ HOPE
1 PORTUGUESE WATER DOG

George Mitchell's "Mitch-tail #2009"

INGREDIENTS:

2 OZ IRISH WHISKEY
1/2 TSP ANIS
1/2 TSP TRIPLE SEC
1/4 TSP MARASCHINO
LIQUEUR
1 TWIST OF ORANGE PEEL
1 OLIVE
1 TSP DIPLOMATIC GENIUS

Mixing Instructions

Shake Irish whiskey, anis, triple sec, and maraschino with ice and strain into a cocktail glass. Add the twist of orange peel, top with the olive, and serve.

Action Instructions

Bartender must remove all preconditions for enjoying the drink, save the promise from the customer that he/she will not engage in a bar fight and will address grievances through dialogue. Or a walk-off. Customer should then have a walk off with a party member of their choice.

50/50 Years War Martini

Mixing Instructions

In a mixing glass half-filled with ice cubes, combine the gin and vermouth. Stir well. Strain into a cocktail glass and garnish with the olive. Sprinkle with real tears.

Action Instructions

Give customer some Arab Shame/Jewish Guilt for allowing the conflict to last this long then tell them to register for the upcoming J Street Conference. Really guilt them if they're not coming to the conference. Seriously, your mother would be proud. 😊

INGREDIENTS:

1.5 OZ GIN
1.5 OZ DRY VERMOUTH
1 COCKTAIL OLIVE
1 OZ REAL TEARS FROM
ISRAELI MOTHER
1 OZ REAL TEARS FROM
PALESTINIAN MOTHER
1 DOLLOP ARAB SHAME
1 DOLLOP JEWISH GUILT

Oy, Enough With the Blood!-y Mary!

INGREDIENTS:

1 1/2 OZ VODKA
3 OZ TOMATO JUICE
1 DASH LEMON JUICE
1/2 TSP WORCESTERSHIRE
SAUCE
2-3 DROPS TABASCO SAUCE
1 WEDGE LIME
1 OLIVE
1 TBLSP CEASEFIRE SAUCE

Mixing Instructions

Shake all ingredients (except lime wedge & olive) with ice and strain into an old-fashioned glass over ice cubes. Add salt and pepper to taste. Add the wedge of lime and serve.

Action Instructions

Customer must pour some of their drink out on floor (or in friends cup) to honor their fallen comrades.

The Shared Jerusalem Martini

Mixing Instructions

Stir gin and vermouth over ice cubes in a mixing glass. Strain into a cocktail glass, add the olive, and serve.

Action Instructions

The customer should first hug a Jew, a Christian, a Muslim and an Armenian and then you can award them with their beverage. Customer should yell "I'm looking for a Jew to hug!" then hug a Jew. Then "I'm looking for a Christian to hug!" etc. If an Armenian is unavailable (they're always busy!), a Wandering Aramean will do.

INGREDIENTS:

1.5 OZ GIN
3/4 OZ DRY VERMOUTH
1 OLIVE
1/2 OZ GROUP HUG

J Street's Conference Martini

INGREDIENTS:

1.5 OZ VODKA
3/4 OZ DRY VERMOUTH
1 OLIVE
1 OPPORTUNITY KNOCKIN'
2 OZ COURAGE
1 HIGH FIVE

Mixing Instructions:

Shake the vodka and vermouth together with a number of ice cubes, strain into a cocktail glass, add the olive and serve.

Action Instructions:

Find a special person at the party and ask them on a date to the J Street Conference. Use the following line: "What are YOU doing this October? Wanna join me at J Street Conference in DC? It's gonna be hot. Like me. Oh yeah. High five."
